Mark Fritsche lives in the town of Tomah. He is a 5th generation Army Veteran who currently owns a small business. He is a member of the VFW, the American Legion, and the U.S. Army War College. Fritsche grew up in Eastman, located in southern Crawford County. He and his wife Renee and their three children have lived in the Tomah area for 14 years. Fritsche has been in public service for over 25 years, serving at federal, state, and local levels. Fritsche is running as a moderate/conservative Democrat and is determined to protect the rights of all citizens. Fritsche's campaign is about engaging the community to find common ground to tackle issues affecting our district.



Jayne Swiggum has been a registered nurse for 22 years. She currently lives in Gays Mills. In 2020, she ran for the 32nd State Senate District without taking any donations; after spending only \$261, she earned 33% of the primary vote. Her top three priorities are health care, public education, and affordable housing. She believes in finding common ground on health care, including a cap on insulin prices and affordable COPD medication. She believes we can strengthen our schools by offering teachers competitive wages and benefits so they don't leave the profession. And she believes in working with local municipalities to build more affordable housing.

He has served on the Monroe County Board of Supervisors since 2020, and is the chair of the Property & Maintenance Committee. He also served on the Tomah City Council in 2018, and ran for mayor of Tomah in 2020 and 2022. He supports common sense gun reform, sustainable funding for our public schools, including the repeal of Act 10, and marijuana legalization for those 21 years old or older. He also supports women's rights, including a woman's right to choose, and capping health care premiums and prescription costs for those over the age of 50.
