For 3rd Congressional District



Rebecca Cooke is a farmer and small business owner from Eau Claire. She supports lowering the age of Medicare eligibility and expanding Medicare to cover dental and vision, restructuring the Farm Bill, investing in clean energy, and deferring property taxes for first-time homeowners.
